



# Bowling Mentor Guidelines

*Thank you for your support in making the bowling experience fun.*

1. Keep scores for each game
  - a. Enter the score that is noted at the end of the 10<sup>th</sup> frame on the score sheet.
  - b. Tally the total team scores (including their handicap) that is presented on the bottom right column of the bowling scoresheet visible on the screen.



- c. If there is a question about the scores, please contact a board member.
  - d. At the end of the 3 games, give the score sheet to a board member
2. If necessary, prompt the bowlers when it is their turn to bowl and make sure that they do not bowl out of turn or, on the wrong lane.
3. Contact any board member if there is a question and/or issues with the automatic scorer and/or the lanes that you cannot address.
4. If you have any other questions and/or concerns, please contact a board member.

## **Reminders:**

- ✓ Bowlers must be courteous
- ✓ Bowlers who are not present before the end of the first frame (shoes on and ready to bowl), will wait to bowl at the start of the next game.
- ✓ Bowlers should be seated at the table when it is not their turn to bowl. If they have difficulty with sitting, they can stand at the counter behind the tables.
- ✓ No cell phones and/or digital devices in use during bowling unless it is a required behavior modification. *Thank you for understanding that this includes the mentors at the tables (modeling requested behavior).*
- ✓ If you have any questions, please feel free to ask a board member.
